DIRECTIONS:

IMPORTANT: If your route includes I-87 (the Adirondack Northway) to the Champlain Bridge, please note that the bridge, which spanned Lake Champlain between Crown Point, N.Y., and Chimney Point, Vermont, via NY Route 185 and VT Route 17, was closed in October. Please use the route shown below. There is also expanded ferry service for vehicles both south and north of Vergennes.

From Boston: take Interstate 93 to Interstate 89 (at Bow, NH) and follow I-89 to exit 1 at Woodstock, Vermont. Follow Route 4 to Rutland, and turn North (right) onto Route 7 to Vergennes. At Vergennes, follow the signs to 22A, drive through town, over the bridge, and turn right on Pantan Road, then right on Basin Harbor Road and proceed for six miles.

From Hartford: take Interstate 91 North to exit 6 at Rockingham, Vermont. Turn left on Route 103 to Rutland, and then North (right) on Route 7 to Vergennes. At Vergennes, follow the signs to 22A, drive through town, over the bridge, and turn right on Pantan Road, then right on Basin Harbor Road and proceed for six miles.

From Montreal: take Route 10 East to the Champlain Bridge. Take Route 133 to the border into Vermont, and go South on Interstate 89. Take exit 13 to I-189, and get off on Route 7 South. Follow Route 7 to Vergennes, go through town and follow the signs for Route 22A. Drive over the bridge and turn right on Pantan Road, then right on Basin Harbor Road and proceed for six miles.

From New York: take the New York Thruway to Exit 24 at Albany. Take Interstate 87 North (Adirondack Northway) to exit 20, get off and turn left onto Route 9. Turn left onto NY149 for 11 miles. Turn left onto US Rte. 4. After crossing into VT, take exit 2 and turn left onto VT Rte. 22A North to Vergennes. Drive past the cemetery in Vergennes on your left and turn left onto Pantan Road and proceed for 1.5 miles. Turn right onto Basin Harbor Road and proceed for six miles.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Only purebred Scottish Deerhounds may be entered. All entries shall be individually registered with the American Kennel Club, the Federation Cynologique Internationale, an ASFA-recognized foreign or ASFA Board approved registry.

Any entry marked "First time entered" must present the judge-signed ASFA Hound Certification or waiver certificate AND a copy of the hound's registration to the secretary BEFORE entries close. Keep a copy of the certification for your records. A Field Secretary shall refuse any entry for the Open, Veteran or Limited stake marked "First Time Entered" if it is not accompanied by a Hound Certification, unless the hound has a title which waives this requirement, and a copy of the hound's registration. FTE entries without a hound certification/waiver certificate will be considered incomplete and will not be accepted. Certification waived for single stake entries only (still need copy of registration).

- All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the trial.
- Stakes will be split into flights by public random draw if the entry in any one stake is 20 or more hounds at time of the draw.
- All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces unless excused, dismissed, or disqualified.
- Bitches in season, hounds with breed disqualifications and hounds lame at roll call will be excused and entry fees refunded. Each entry will be examined at roll call for breed disqualifications.
- Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched.
- Certification runs and practice will **NOT** be offered.
- Monorchid, cryptorchid, spayed or neutered hounds without breed disqualifications may be entered.
- A penalty of \$5 will be assessed for any loose hound not competing in the course in progress.

STAKES OFFERED

OPEN: Each stake shall consist of entries of only Scottish Deerhounds, dog and bitches that have met certification requirements, excluding ASFA Field Champions of record. ***A copy of the hound's registration must be submitted with a hound's first ASFA field trial entry.***

FIELD CHAMPION: Any ASFA Field Champion Scottish Deerhound.

VETERAN: Any eligible Scottish Deerhound whose age is at least six years. ***The hound certification requirement applies to hounds entered for the first time. Points and placements go to a V-Fch or V-LCM title.***

SINGLES: Any eligible Scottish Deerhound including those disqualified to run in other stakes. **First time single entrants do not need a hound certification/waiver but must submit a copy of the hound's registration. Not eligible for Best of Breed.**

BREEDER: Any two Scottish Deerhounds bred by the same person and designated at the time of entry.

KENNEL: Any two Scottish Deerhounds in one of the regular stakes owned and kenneled by the same person and designated at the time of entry

RIBBONS: Rosettes will be awarded for all placements 1st – NBQ and BOB. See insert for listing of Challenge Trophies and Perpetual Trophies

AWARDS:

BOB: ASFA provides a plaque to the winner of the ASFA trial with ASFA logo, club, year and space for the winner's name.

Rosettes and trophies will be awarded for all placements, BOB and first in Breeder and Kennel Stakes.

BOB: 8" diameter plate with raised Deerhound offered by Margaret Sudekum DVM in memory of Fitzhugh Eloise FCh

Open Stake: 1st-NBQ – leather leads offered by Gale & George Lovato; the BOB representative from the Open Stake will also receive "The Art of Medieval Hunting: the Hound and the Hawk" by John Cummins, offered by Barb Heidenreich and Richard Hawkins, Fernhill

Running order will be open, field champion, veteran, and singles.

REMINDERS - FIRST TIME ENTRIES

ENTRY FORM

The appropriate box on the entry form must be checked noting that this is the first ASFA trial for the hound.

COPY of REGISTRATION

A copy of the hound's registration must be submitted with a hound's first ASFA field trial entry. This includes hounds entered in the Singles Stake.

HOUND CERTIFICATION

Certifications: Any entry marked "First time entered", must present the judge-signed ASFA Hound Certification or waiver certificate and a copy of the hound's registration to the secretary **BEFORE** entries close (*keep a copy of the certification for your records*). Entries without a hound certification/waiver certificate and/or copy of the hound's registration will be considered **incomplete and will not be accepted**. First time single entrants do not need a hound certification/waiver.

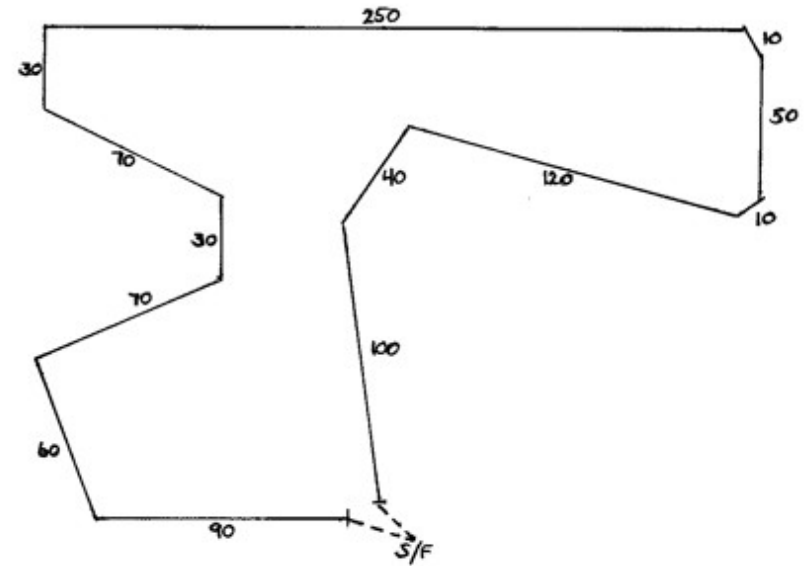
